The multi-line screen makes serving easy

The colour LCD display screen can be tilted and the contrast adjusted to avoid glare and reflection.

Descriptive customer display

The fully adjustable 2-line alphanumeric customer display shows purchases as they are entered and can be viewed by the customer from the rear or either side. An advertising message can scroll across the display between sales.

Silent, fast, thermal printing

The twin thermal alpha-numeric printers operate at 13 lines per second. Your company logo can be printed on each receipt. With no ribbon to replace or fade, receipts of the same exceptional clarity are produced every time.

Clerk Interrupt

For busy bars and pubs the ML-790's clerk interrupt feature permits up to 50 operators to serve and store rounds of drinks on the same unit concurrently by clerk ID or magnetic touch key.

Floating Clerks

Clerks may start or finalise food and drinks orders on any ML-790 in the system, avoiding queues at the registers and speeding food and drinks orders to the bar.

Scroll Back/Scroll Forward

Customers' bar or restaurant bills can be previewed, item-by-item, on any ML-790 in the system and corrected, if necessary. Even after presentation of the bill, extra items may be added and a new bill printed or disputed items removed.

Half Pints and Doubles

Special Half Pint and Double buttons simplify the keyboard layout and provide greater accuracy in stocktaking.

Kitchen/Bar Printers

Each ML-790 can drive up to 3 printers for speedy, electronic transfer of food and drinks orders to kitchen and bar. Several ML-790s can transmit orders at the same time and the kitchen/bar printer remembers them in its buffer and prints them rapidly in consecutive order. There can be up to 8 kitchen/bar printers in a linked system. Cooking and dispensing instructions are highlighted in red to facilitate service. In the event of a printer failure, the information is automatically re-routed to another printer as a fail-safe back up.

Memory Billing and Floating Bills

Drinks in the bar followed by a meal in the restaurant and coffee in the lounge are easily tracked to the customer's clearly presented bill - or charged to his account. In-house credit cards can be used. Separate tables can be combined onto one bill.

Intuitive fixed price menus speed service

ML-790's can hold a number of fixed price menus. If, for example, there are 4 covers, the display advances automatically to 'Mains' after the 4 starters have been entered. Servers are prompted to enter vegetables and cooking instructions. When the table number is entered again, the display opens at 'Desserts'.

Reward your customers' loyalty

You can offer your customers account cards that can be swiped through the integral card reader.

Cards can be prepaid...

A monetary value can be allocated against the card account number - either via the ML-790 or a back office PC. Cards can have credit limits and allow discounts by product or amount. Customers' purchases are automatically debited when the card is swiped. To encourage pre-payment, up to six different discounts can be applied to your product range and triggered automatically when cards are swiped. Customers can top up their cards even during a purchase.

...or paid on account

Alternatively, purchase amounts can be accumulated against customers' card accounts and a report printed by the ML-790 or back office PC - say, monthly - so that invoices can be sent to your customers.

Inter-register communication

Where there are several sales points, ML-790s can be linked to each other. Information - for example, new products or price changes - entered onto one ML-790 are sent automatically to the other ML-790s in the system. In the other direction, sales data from all the ML-790s in the business can be consolidated onto one ML-790 for easy management reporting.
